world.

Similar (though obviously not *exact*) to the Weimar Republic in Germany of the early 1930s that unwittingly ushered in blatant German fascism, the Obama / Biden / Rahm Emanuel administration (in concert with a pathetic U.S. Congress) are haplessly laying the foundation for a not-too-distant and *blatant* form of U.S. authoritarianism / fascism, thanks to the-thus far-relatively weak response of the U.S. left to the Obama administration's hypocrisy, and the shamelessly opportunist, very well financed and growingly organized - often fanatical-rightwing opposition locally and nationally.


